Wobble Trap – Coming Soon!

Wobble trap is unique from all other games. There are 5 positions on a pyramid structure. The machine is hidden (no one knows where the target will go). The machine is random in its throwing up, down, left, right.

Your first call is a single; you can shoot twice at it if you miss the first.

Your next is a report pair; then another report pair.

Everyone shifts stations and you start again with a single with one or two shots, then two sets of report pairs.

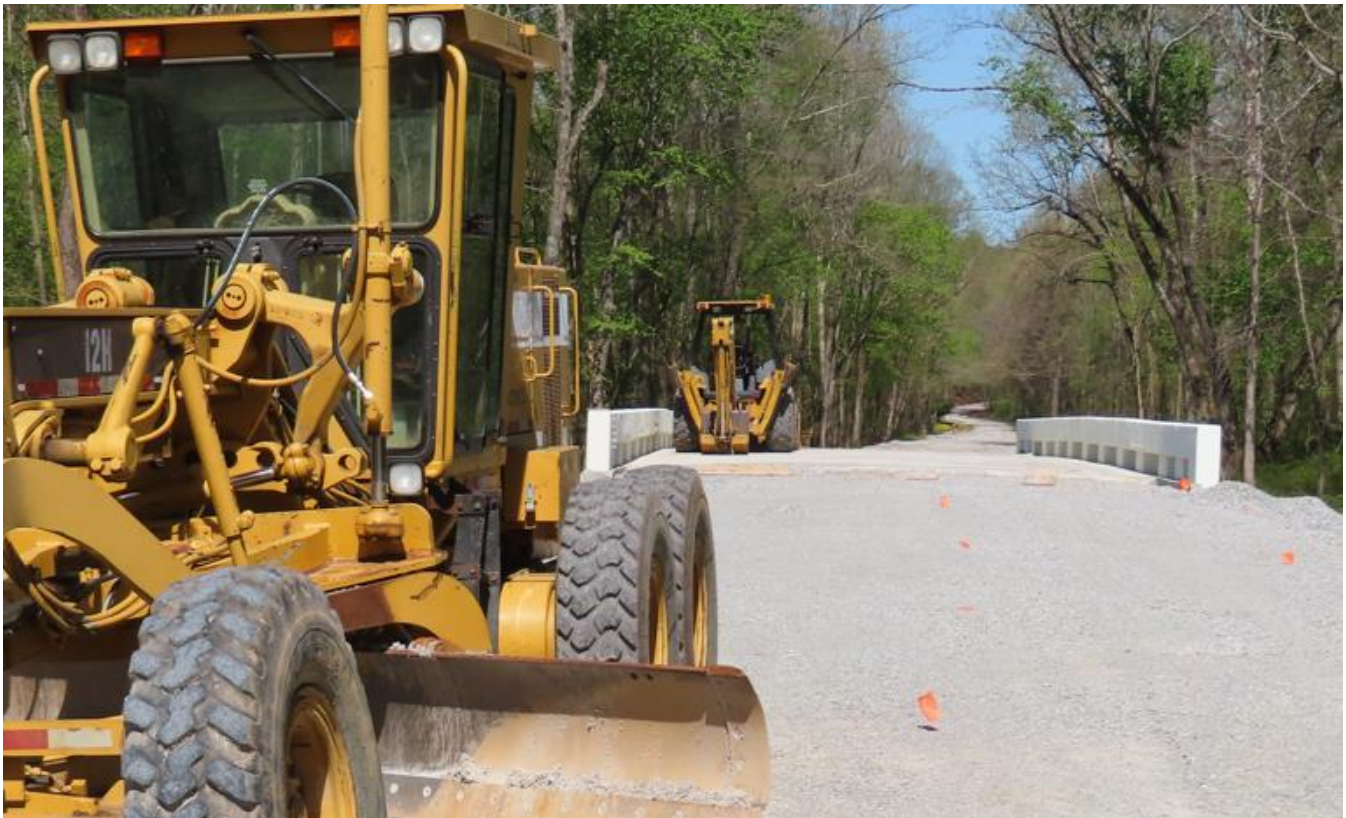
Henry County Gun Club membership has approved the construction of a Wobble Trap shooting station.

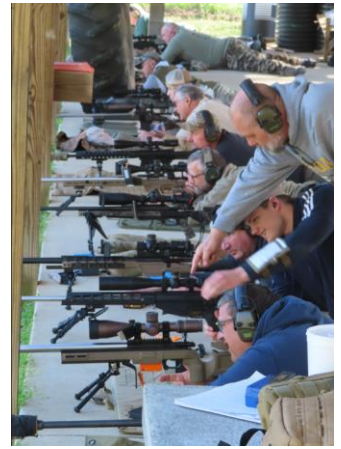

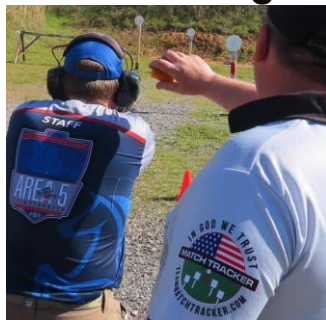

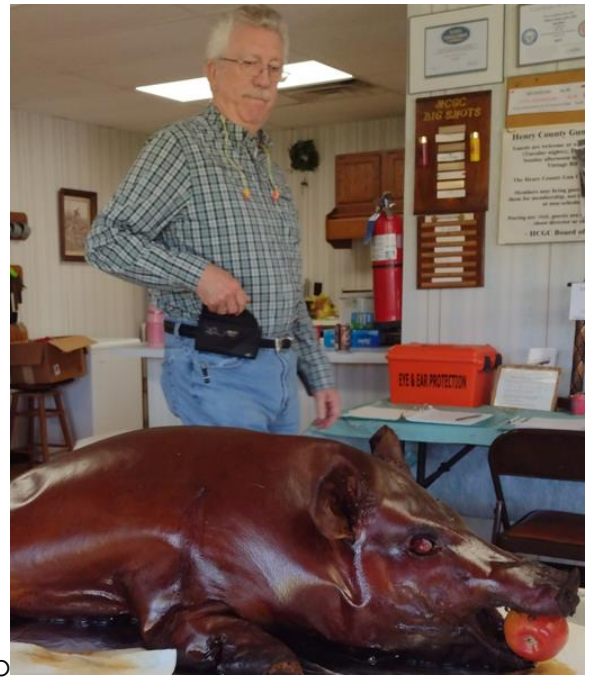
