Highlights of the MAY Meeting

Membership: Total: **349** = 316 Full Members; 31 Probationary; 2 BOG-approved.

Trap/Skeet Totals: Skeet: 44 (137 rounds); Trap: 24 (73 rounds);

Approval by BOG:

BOG approved \$3758 for **Louisville Web Nerds** for a complete overhaul of our website with new layout, easier menus and interface capabilities.

BOG approved \$16,050 for **Norwood Construction** for upgrades and repairs to the 600-yard range to include repairing the washed-out bridge and culvert, enlarging the parking lot, adding dirt to the 5 berms grading, improving drainage and adding rock to the driveway from hilltop to 500-yard.

BOG approved \$54 for 40 "chamber flags" to be stored in the orange boxes at the 100- & 600-yard ranges along with the hearing and eye protection already provided.

BOG approved \$72 to Tony Lacy for meals served at last 2 matches.

Highlights of the MAY Meeting - continued

Old (unfinished) Business:

Update on starting regular "Basic Handgun Handling Skills Training" with Joe Pat Hutson as Trainer. Several classes already held. Classes being scheduled as time permits. Members on Joe Pats list will be contacted when next class is scheduled.

New Business:

Vote on improvements to the lower range:

BOG approved \$4000 to get all the pistol berms trimmed by Adam Powell with option to have it done annually for \$3000.

BOG approved \$6200 to Cutting Edge for refurbishing driveway with Harley rake and adding gravel from the entrance asphalt to the flagpole at the 100, Harley rake and add gravel to the pistol bays, fixing 3 broken culverts and control drainage from pistol bay and 50-yard to prevent erosion.

BOG approved \$16,050 for Norwood Construction for upgrades and repairs to the 600-yard range to include repairing the washed-out bridge and culvert, enlarging the parking lot, adding dirt to the 5 berms grading, improving drainage and adding rock to the driveway from hilltop to 500-yard.

New Business:

Vote passed on expenditure of \$3758 to **Louisville Web Nerds** for a complete overhaul of our website with new layout, easier menus and interface capabilities. That's \$3500 for the upgrade and a couple of months of Support at \$129/month.

Vote passed on expenditure of \$16,050 to **Norwood Construction** for upgrades and repairs to the 600-yard range to include repairing the washed-out bridge and culvert, enlarging the parking lot, adding dirt to the 5 berms grading, improving drainage and adding rock to the driveway from hilltop to 500-yard line.

Vote passed for **Adam Powell** on \$4000 to get all the berms trimmed and considering \$3000 each year to keep them maintained going forward.

Vote passed for **Cutting Edge** on \$6200 to refurbish driveway with Harley rake and add gravel from the entrance asphalt to the flagpole at the 100, Harley rake and add gravel to the pistol bays, fix broken 3 broken culverts and control drainage from pistol bay and 50-yard to prevent erosion.
