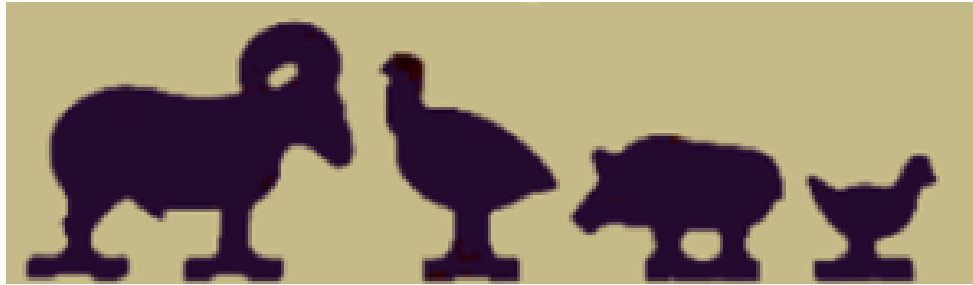

**Old (unfinished) Business:** Planning Committee for 2026 will be meeting soon to discuss running electricity for lighting and Wi-Fi to the 100/200-yard and the 600-yard range.

**New Business:** Plan being developed for running electricity to the 100-yd and 600-yard range. Total cost will be \$8450 to be discussed and voted on at the next meeting. This will enable lights, Wi-Fi, fans and outlets to these areas. \$840 approved for 6 picnic tables for various shooting areas. A 5-Stand Clays project is approved \$1755 to get started with an additional \$2000 for completion. \$100 approved for the Henry County Rescue Squad.

# Project *Appleseed* Rifle Clinics

At Henry County Gun Club scheduled for:

**May 16-17** for the 25 meter event on the pistol bays.

**October 10-11** for the Known Distance on the 600.

The capacity of both events is **15**.

Two have already signed up for the 25m event.

In order to attend the KD, shooters must first have come to a 25m event.

Here, you can find Information and Registration for the events.

Also on the home page, the selection, "How To Prepare", contains much information for a 25m event.

Most shooters at these events use .22s. Almost any of these can be used but those with removable magazines are more user friendly. Any type of sights are welcome. Those with scopes usually have the scopes located too far to the rear. They should be moved as far forward as possible.

Some scope mounts are available to move them even more forward. To obtain the most from these clinics, slings are recommended; and the best, and least expensive, are the 1-¼ inch GI slings which are available from the Appleseed store. I will have a few of these on hand.

They also require 1-¼-inch swivels.

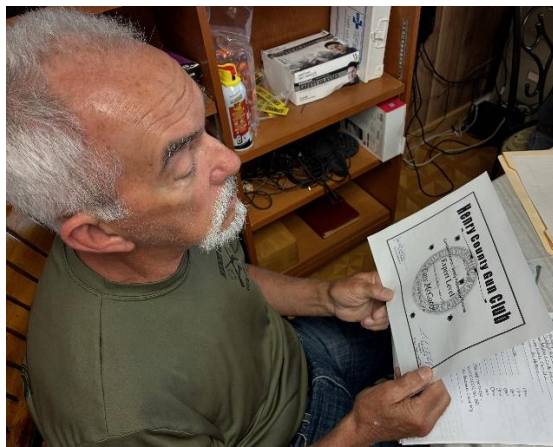

Training combines classroom time in preparation for practical exercises in the Pistol Bays.

**\*Drawing & holstering   \*Grip Acquisition   \*Sight alignment   \*Trigger control  
\*Movement/pivot drills   \*4-step Drawing drills   \*Reload drills**

5 shooters per session maximum.

95% of targets will be at 7-yards with some drills with targets as close as 2 feet, 5 yards, 7 yards and out to 10 to 15 yards to determine how far out you can hit.

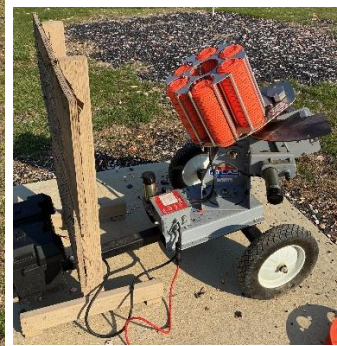
